We aim to minimise the environmental impact of our production processes through careful evaluation and monitoring to ensure that waste is minimised. Wherever possible we promote the efficient use of resources including water, electricity, and raw materials.

We encourage our employees to work in an environmentally responsible manner.

In distributing our products we aim to minimise carbon emissions through the careful selection, purchase and use of appropriate Company vehicles.

We aim to purchase recycled, recyclable or re-furbished products and materials where these alternatives are available, economical and suitable for our product range and office use.

We operate in compliance with all relevant environmental legislation and strive to use pollution prevention and environmental best practices in all we do by avoiding the unnecessary use of hazardous materials and products and taking all reasonable steps to protect human health and safety and the environment when such materials must be used, stored and disposed of.
